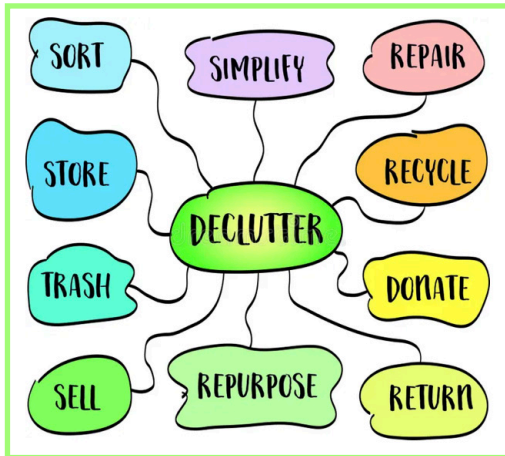


Decluttering
